

Alphabet Matching

Objective

Students will improve their letter recognition skills by matching pairs of alphabet cards.

Ages

3-6 years old

Materials

- 1 laminated alphabet mat for each student (see below)
- Small magnetic or foam letters (uppercase or lowercase)
- Cup or small basket to hold the magnetic letters or tiles

How to Play

1. Introduce the activity and explain to the students that they will be matching magnetic letters (or foam letters) to their alphabet boards. Model a few examples.
 - a. You can have students match uppercase to uppercase letters, lowercase to lowercase letters, or uppercase to lowercase letters.
2. Give each student an alphabet board and a set of small magnetic or foam letters.
3. Ask the child to pick a letter, identify it, and then find the matching letter on their alphabet mat.
 - a. They should place the magnetic or foam letter on the board on top of its match.
4. Have the child choose another letter and repeat the process until all of the letters have been placed on the mat.
5. Observe to ensure the students match the letters correctly and support as needed.
