

Student Name: Letter Sort

Objective

Students will identify and sort letters of the alphabet, including the ones in their name.

Ages

3-6 years old

Materials

- Name sorting page for each child (included below)
- Magnetic letters or letter tiles
- Paper cups or small baskets to hold the letters or tiles
- Name tag or for each child

How to Play

1. Give each student a name sorting sheet, their name tag, and a basket or cup of magnetic letters or letter tiles.
 - a. Make sure they have all the letters in their name plus some additional letters!
2. Students should choose one letter at a time and identify it by saying its name out loud.
3. Then, have them place the letter in the correct area (letters in their name vs. letters not in their name).
 - a. If they're not sure, encourage them to look at their name tag.
4. Optional - after sorting all of the letters, students can take the letters from the "letters in your name" space and practice spelling their name by putting them in the correct order or put all of the letters from their basket in alphabetical order.
